On Saturday 11/26/11, at approximately 1000 hours, I was participating with the Southern Arizona Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Task Force during its Thanksgiving weekend holiday deployment.

Briefing for the task force was conducted at the Tucson Police Department (TPD) west side service station located at 1310 West Miracle Mile.

Following the regional briefing of the task force, I conducted a briefing for the Pima County Sheriff's Department (PCSD) sobriety check point briefing.

NOTE: This was done via Power Point presentation.

Deputy R. W. Hierstein #6717 and Deputy R. R. Murray #1275 were absent for the initial briefing and were briefed upon their return, as they were involved in a DUI and a suspended driver's license investigation at the time of the briefing.

The location of the check point was established to be located at 1850 West River Road, as was approved by the Special Operations Commander, and the Support Division Operations Commander.

Once the briefing was completed, staff went to the check point location and began set up. The check point became operational at 2045 hours and concluded at 2315 hours.

There were 2,079 vehicles that passed through the check point, two field sobriety tests that were conducted and one DUI arrest.

Additionally there were three other arrests. One for a suspended driver's license from a periphery staff member, a warrant that was served as well as drug paraphernalia.

Once the check point was done, I completed a Force Commander's Summary detailing the operations of the check point.

Following the check point, involved staff members were deployed to the surrounding metropolitan districts for DUI saturation patrols.

This concludes my involvement in this case.
