Traffic Stop Leads To Seizure of Drugs And Guns

July 20, 2020

On Friday, July 19, 2020, at about 10:00 p.m. Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a civil traffic violation in the area of Flowing Wells Road and Rillito Road. During the course of the traffic stop, synthetic narcotic pills, a handgun, just over two pounds of methamphetamines, and about \$12,000 in cash were located.

The Major Investigation Unit took over the investigation, which led to a storage shed, also on Flowing Wells Road. In the shed, detectives located 24 pounds of methamphetamine, nearly a pound of heroin, 37 grams of Marijuana, and just under 2 pounds of synthetic narcotic pills. A 12 gauge shotgun and an AR-15 rifle were also located in the shed.

The total street value of the drugs located is approximately \$130,000.

The driver of the vehicle, 46-year old Michael Montgomery, was arrested for Possession of Dangerous Drugs for Sale and Misconduct involving Weapons and booked into the Pima County Adult Detention Complex.
